Dear Parent / Carer

Thank you to so many parents and carers for attending our recent Year 11 Information Evening. I hope you have had time since, to read through the information given, which we sent out to parents recently. This link will also remain on the Year 11 letters section of the Midhurst Rother College website for you to refer to over the coming months, as a lot of information on our timeline for the year is contained there.

Year 11 is always an intense, busy year for all involved and we have high expectations of our students. For them to earn GCSE grades they can be proud of, there is a lot of work to do. As explained at the Information Evening, we are challenging our Year 11 students this year to earn their invitation to Prom 2024. Prom will take place on Thursday 4 July 2023 at Old Thorns Hotel, Liphook. Attending prom is a privilege. This event is an opportunity to reward hard work at school and celebrate the bonds of mutual respect and friendship formed over the last five years together.

We want to encourage all the students to adopt successful work habits and fulfil their potential next summer. We are therefore running a points system to reward students who do the right things every day. In brief, positive points are earned for attendance, punctuality, completing homework and working well in school. Arbor feeds our "Passport to Prom" totaliser with all the data we need each week, to see who is most deserving of an invitation to prom, or even better, a discounted ticket. Passport to Prom does not factor in current or predicted grades, so please be assured that students of all academic abilities can earn an invitation to Prom, if they are putting in the effort required.

Students lose "Passport to Prom" points when they are absent from school, late to lessons, missing homework or making poor choices regarding behaviour and uniform. We have 215 students in the cohort and our booking with Old Thorns for 4 July is currently for 160 students. This is a group size we may increase if we have many more than 160 students with excellent scores in the new year.

To secure our venue we ask that parents pay a £10 deposit as soon as possible. The overall ticket cost will be £57 to include a soft drink, two-course meal and entertainments. Once the deposit has been paid, we ask that the final balance is settled no later than Wednesday 17 April. This works out at under £10 per month if you wish to pay in instalments. Deposits paid are <u>refundable</u> in the unlikely event that your child scores insufficient Passport to Prom points to attend the evening.
