


SIXTH FORM Harwell Electron Accelerator Trip

Mr Coombes and Mr Burton took 10 of our Sixth Form students to the Harwell Science Park. We had a virtual tour of the Boulby mine laboratory (11.1km underground, searching for Dark Matter in the universe) and then visiting Diamond Light Source to see the largest particle accelerator in the country, including seeing the building of the next generation model. We also saw some of the experiments that are currently underway there - analysing bone density in osteoperosis, analysing solar generation film possibilities to name just two. We also reviewed data from the Large

Hadron Collider to search for the Higgs Boson, before seeing all the different companies at the park and discussing the apprenticeships available and other routes into Science, Technology and Engineering careers.


